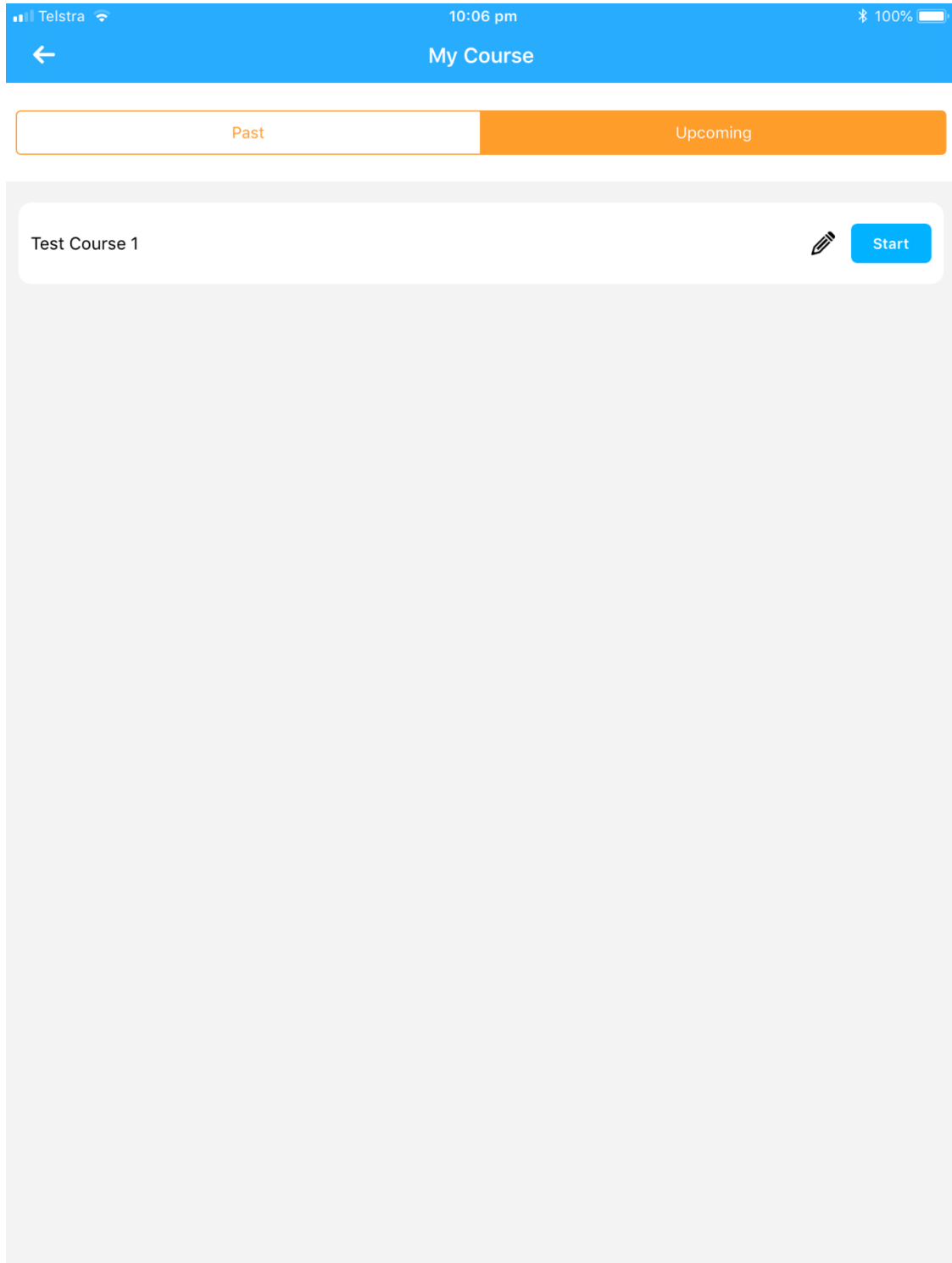




Marine & Car Time Trials



A course set up ready for an event can still be checked and edited by pressing the edit icon (the pencil) or you can go straight to the event (Start Button)

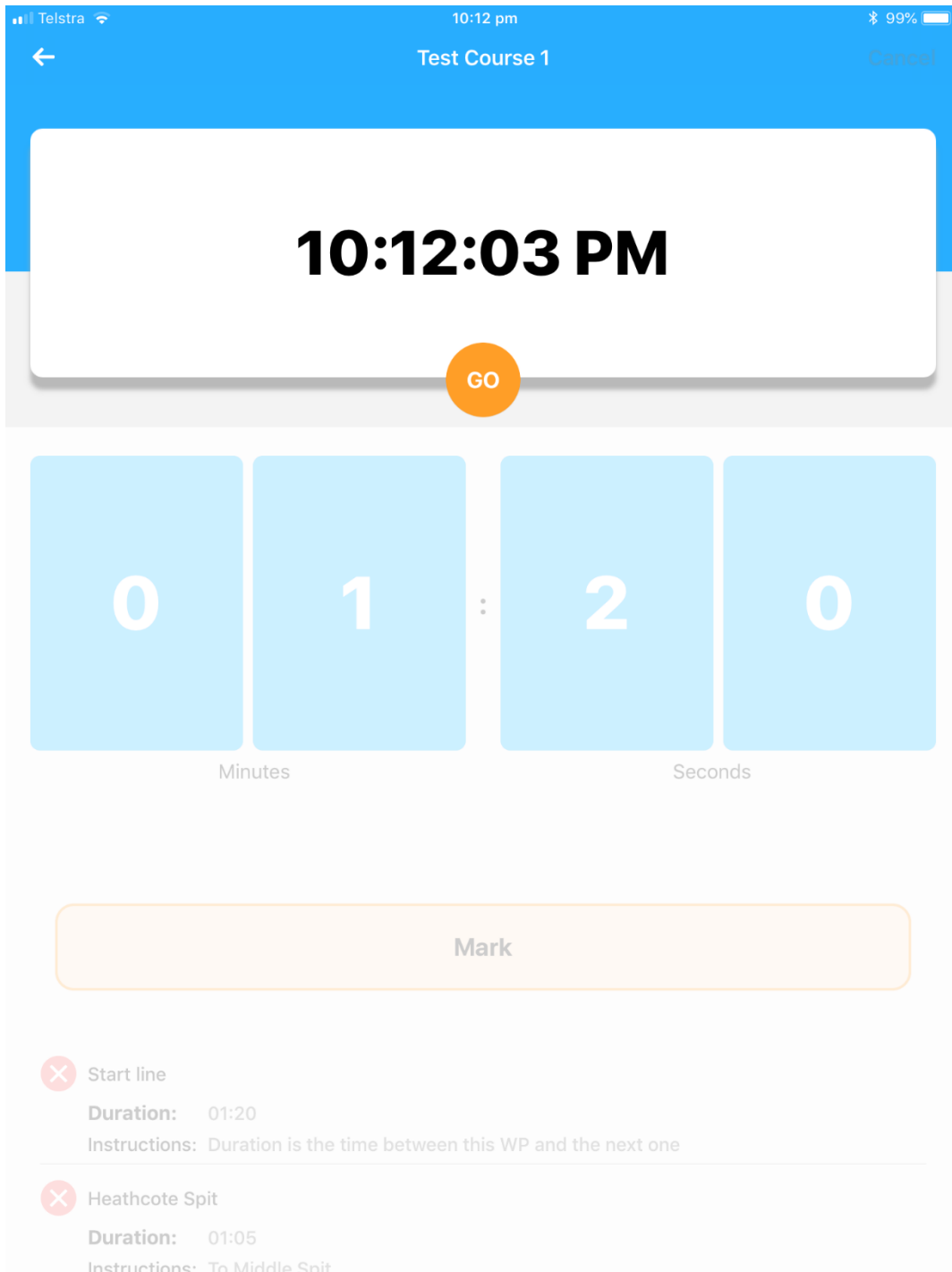

If you are ready, press start button. The event screen will appear showing the race clock. You can synchronize this clock with the Event Race Clock by touching the white clock screen

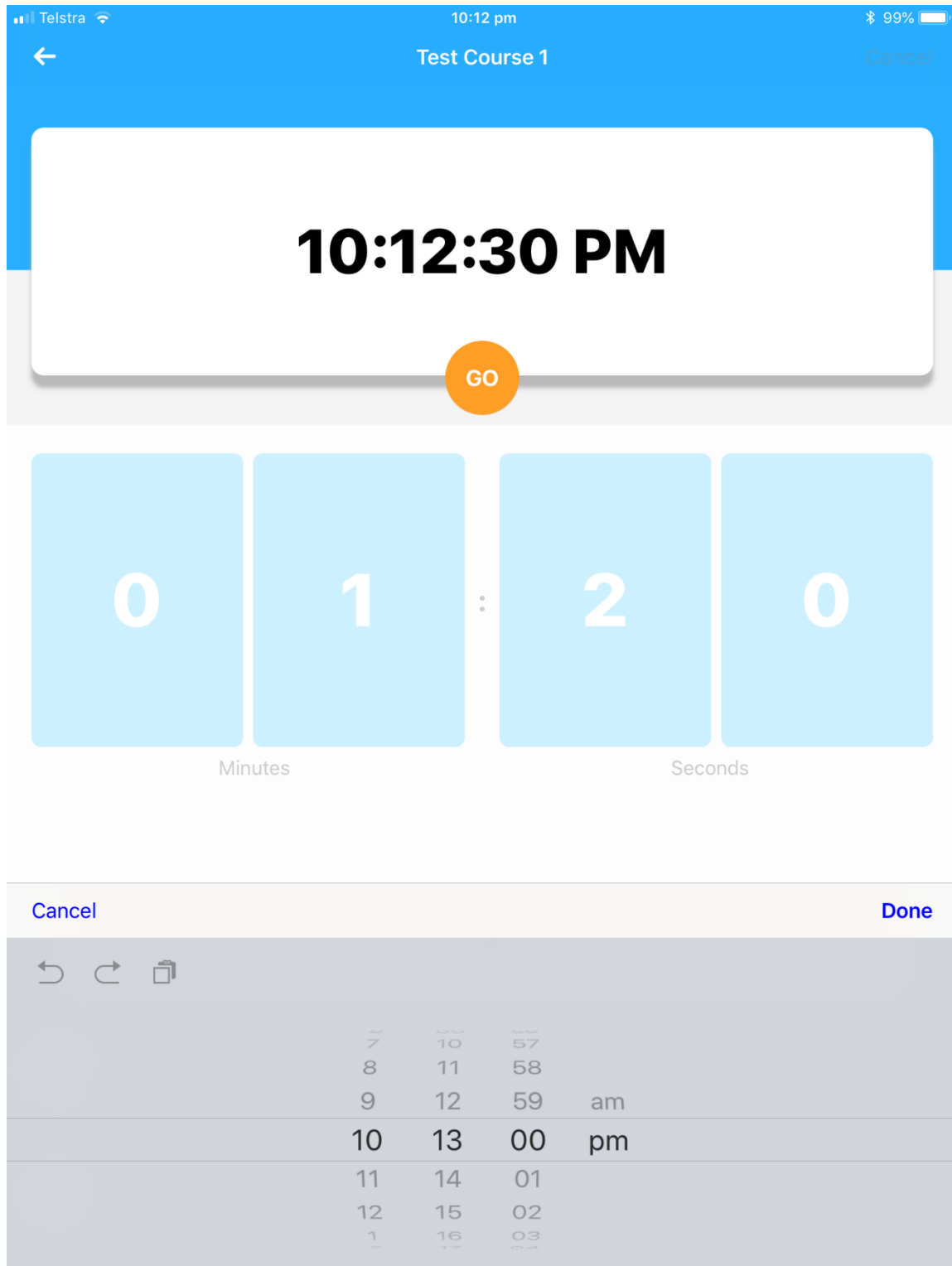

If there is a difference (even a second or two) you can sync the event by rounding up to the next minute i.e. 10:13:00 in the section shown below, count down with the race clock and press done on the stroke of 10:13:00

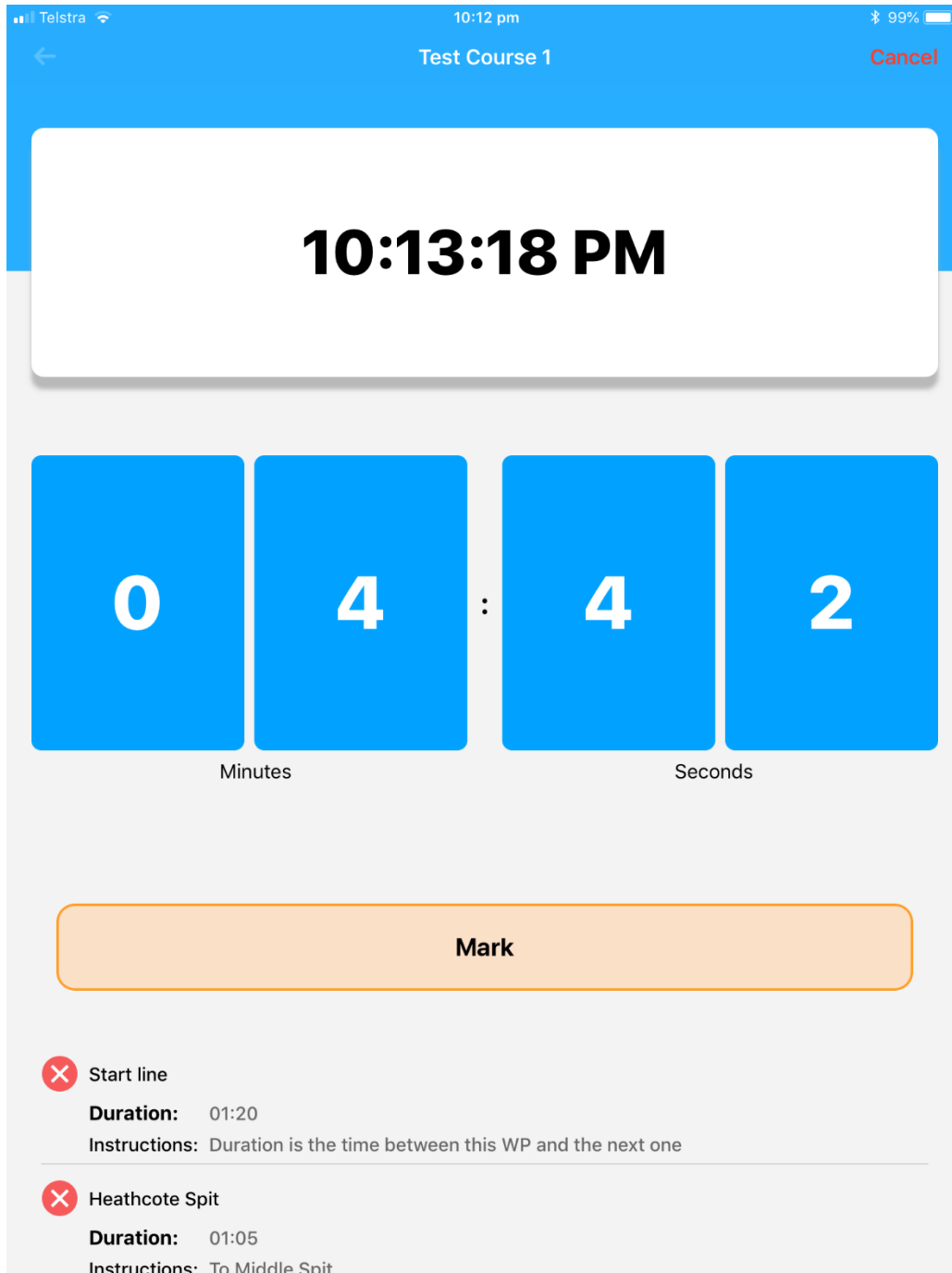

Once satisfied the clock is in sync, press the go button to start the countdown timers. The App will only let you do this when you are 59 minutes or closer to the actual start time. From this point on, you can cancel if you have made a mistake and set up the course again by changing start time but this can only be done up to 3 minutes before your allocated start time.

The countdown will take you to the actual start time. You must press the Mark button at 00:00 (or when your skipper accelerates) to start the event.
